Course Syllabus

Course Description:

This course will survey the basic foundations of the call to the Christian ministry. The course will examine the basic and most fundamental questions that the student needs to consider for suitability for Christian ministry

Course Purpose:

Enable the student to develop a basic and sound theological understanding of what it means to answer a call to ministry. Help those who are struggling with their initial call to Christian ministry and those who presently serve ministry context.

Course Objectives:

1. Encourage student to discover, develop and nurture their call to ministry within the context of God's biblical revelation.
2. Encourage student to develop a balance between their vocational call to Christian Ministry and/or the marketplace through dependence upon the Holy Spirit and God's word.
3. Lead student to develop the ability to understand the call to ministry and to help others do the same.

Course Procedures:

1. Each student is expected to faithfully study all assignments and attend classes regularly. Absences should be for true emergencies. Only three excused absences are allowed.
2. The required text for the course is: The King James, New King James Versions of the Bible. The textbooks for the course are *"Is God Calling Me? Answering the Question Every Leader Asks."* Jeff Iorg, (Nashville: B & H Publishing Group, 2008, \$9.99 and Henry Blackaby, *"The Power of the Call"*. It can be purchased in Full Gospel Kingdom Church Bookstore, local Christian book store or online.
3. Using a Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible students are required to turn in a weekly summary of their reading and reflection on at least five scriptures on the subject of ministry and calling
4. A five page research paper is due during the course for undergraduate students and two papers are due for graduate students. **Late papers start with the grade of C.** All papers must demonstrate correct spelling, grammar and syntax. All papers will be prepared using the **KBI Writing Guide (MLS Style) Format.**
5. Course testing will be: **Two quizzes, mid-term exam, final exam**
6. Group project (power point)

7. All test questions will be drawn from course texts and student lecture notes.
